In addition, we run a targeted mainstream provision at one of our partner schools to support pupils with SEMH needs, who have an EHCP.

We are looking for a Science Teacher, able to teach Key stage 3 and 4 with a wide range of abilities. You need to be passionate about engaging young people in learning and deliver exciting and practical opportunities in the classroom. The ability to offer an additional subject would be an advantage.

Our class sizes are small (6 or less) and we have a strong team of HLTAs who support classes where needed.

You will need good knowledge of how to teach pupils with varying special needs, effective behaviour management and an understanding of the challenges of SEMH teaching. We use the Thrive Approach within our setting to enhance learning around emotional development, resilience and neuroscience.

This is an exciting and varied role where you will be able to make a tangible, positive differences to the lives of the pupils you will teach. The job is demanding, but immensely rewarding.
